The *Beavercreek Sox* are pleased to announce the try-outs for competitive youth baseball for boys who are ages 9, 10, 11, 12, 13, and 14. At least one *Beavercreek Sox* select baseball team will be chosen for each of these 6 age groups. Ages 9 – 14 participate in a competitive league known as the Midwest Ohio Baseball Association. League play consists of a home and away formats as well as post-season tournament play against teams from throughout the Miami Valley. Teams comprised of 15/16, 17/18 year olds participate in Midwest Ohio Baseball League and Acme Baseball League usually.

The *Beavercreek Sox* conduct their practices and home games at **Rotary Park** in Beavercreek. League play begins in mid April or early May and concludes in late June or July, followed by tournament play during the summer.

A player participation fee of **\$225.00** is required of each player.

Try-outs for the *Beavercreek Sox* are **FREE** and will be held at the **Wright State University McClean Gym** on **Monday March 24th and Tuesday March 25th** according to the following schedule:

Monday March 24th and Tuesday March 25th

6:00 - 7:30 PM: 9, 10 and 11 year olds (Special note: any 7th or 8th grader who has participated in school baseball team events)

7:30 - 9:00 PM: 12, 13, 14 and 15 year olds (as defined in OHSAA player eligibility rules and regulations should not attend this tryout)

Wear appropriate gym clothes, tennis shoes, and bring your glove and bat. Do NOT bring any baseballs. There is no pre-registration, as all registration will occur on the evening of the try-outs at the Nutter Center. Please arrive 15 minutes early to complete registration.

In addition, the *Beavercreek Sox* offer competitive baseball league and tournament play for boys ages 15 - 18, with games scheduled from late May through August. For more information about try-out and selection procedures, please contact the listed head coach:
